The Singularity Reshoring Strategy gives investors exposure to key reshoring innovation domains across six dedicated themes: Automation Technologies, Sustainable Resources and Infrastructure, Food Security and Sovereignty, Design and Engineering Software, Biomedical Engineering, and Semiconductor Design & Manufacturing. The strategy includes 50 small- and midcap companies with a high potential to reap the economic benefits from core reshoring innovations. The product structure is a UBS Actively Managed Certificate (AMC). The strategy's composition follows TSG's investment methodology, which screens for innovation across ten Singularity Sectors: Advanced Materials, Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, Bioinformatics, Blockchain, Compute Power, Extended Reality, Internet of Things, New Energy, and Robotics.

Reshoring: The Next Macrotrend – Enabled by Innovation: Reshoring concerns the relocation of manufacturing and related business activities to domestic markets. In the post COVID-19 era, reshoring is gaining momentum as the next global macrotrend, driven by regional economic stimulus policies and concerns over supply-chain resilience, food and energy security, geo-political conflict, national sovereignty and security, and sustainability. **These drivers coincide with opportunities from emerging applied innovations that enable efficient production in domestic markets against lower costs of input factors.**

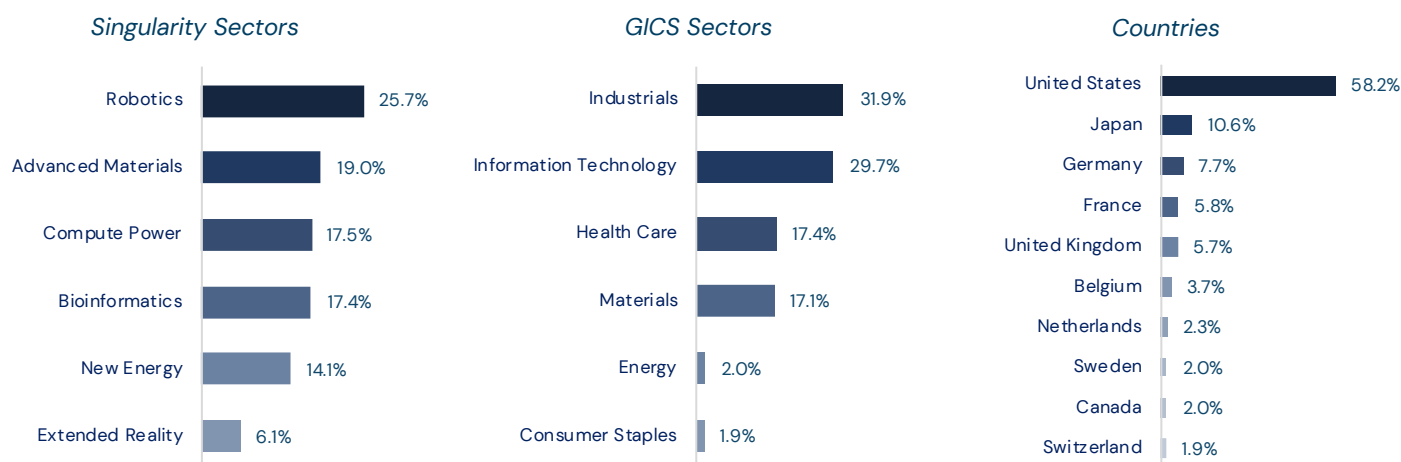
